Second Infraction- Warning will be reiterated; however if student does not respond to correction he/she will miss half recess.


Third Infraction- Student will miss full recess.


Book Orders:

I will be sending Scholastic book orders home each month in your child's take home folder. Ordering through Scholastic provides our class a great opportunity to earn free books. Feel free to order as many or few times as you want. Please send your book order form along with a check (payable to Scholastic) to school with your child. (No cash please). When ordering, book order forms and payment need to be returned to school with your child by the date specified. Scholastic orders may also be placed online by accessing the link found on our class website under "Parent Resources and Links" tab.

Lunch Money:

Please send lunch money in an envelope marked with your child's name and the amount enclosed. This makes it much easier for me to keep track when sending it to the cafeteria. Also, please note that the cafeteria has a **no charge policy**.
